

Geotope 12. Gössering – Seeming Gentle




Red marking: Hiking route according to advance description; green tracks: hiking trails; ©BEV: Federal Office for Calibration and Measurement, 2005.

Access:

West of the village of Weißbriach.

Description of the Geotope

The Gössering creek invites people for a relaxing walk through the gentle valley. The easy-flowing water follows the boundary between the Partnach Formation and the overlying Raibl Formation. The different resistance of these rocks against erosion was responsible for the course of the water. However, the Gössering river has a huge catchment area with many tributaries which after heavy rainfall can result in a torrential river.
