

Here by the deep-blue Lake Wolayersee, you can walk over a fossilised sea bed with corals, sea lilies and squid from primitive times. 3 hour walk to the starting point. No display boards; can only be accessed with a guide or accompanying brochure.




When you follow the Laas geological trail you will discover the only petrified forest in Austria. In addition, thanks to their numerous treasures, the geo-cultural walk and the village will allow you to understand more fully how geology influences our daily lives.





Explore the mysteries of this unique and varied landscape. The idyllic Lake Zollnersee, quiet moorland, gently rolling hills and craggy mountain peaks all have a tale to tell.



In this hiking paradise for all ages, you will encounter plant and animal fossils, colourful rocks and a revolting smell at the sulphur spring!



In the Garnitzenklamm gorge, you will walk alongside roaring emerald-green brooks past fascinating and colourful rock and cliff formations, created by the massive forces of nature.
